Frontiers Musical Scales in Tone Sequences Improve

February 5th, 2018 - Results indicate higher discriminability of anisochrony with musical scales and with longer sequences irrespective of the knowledge of the final tone Such an outcome suggests that the predictability of non temporal properties as enabled by the musical scale pattern can be a factor in determining the sensitivity of time judgments
